Charge:

- 2) Determine if any relationships can be established with non-USG institutions (e.g. Alabama and Florida) to enroll students at CSU, especially in the Summer term.
- 3) Determine if local students, who attend other USG institutions during the regular academic year, can be identified in order to solicit their Summer enrollment at CSU.
- 4) Determine how faculty can assist Enrollment Services in their recruiting efforts.
