Readmission Appeal Panels

May 5th, 2015 (for Summer 2016)

Number of students applied: 13
Number of students readmitted on probation: 9
Number of students denied: 1
Number of students that did not show up: 3

August 11th, 2016 (for Fall 2016)

Number of students applied: 14
Number of students readmitted on probation: 8
Number of students denied: 0
Number of students that did not show up: 6

December 7th, 2016 (for Spring 2017)

Summary of panels:

Students earning an institutional GPA below two are placed on probation. Students that are on probation and earn a semester GPA below two then the student receives their first exclusion and sit out a semester. Students appear before the Readmission Appeals Committee after two exclusions.

At each panel, student appeals were reviewed by the committee, both by examining the students' files and by interviewing the students. The committee members discussed the potential for each student to succeed and the strategies each student needed to employ in order to achieve success. The final decision of the panel was given immediately to each student. Usually, students that are denied readmission fail to communicate a plan for success.
