

New Committee: Honors Education Committee

Charge: The committee will provide advice and oversight for the CSU Honors Program

Membership: Ten faculty members, not including ex-Officio Members, consisting of two from each academic college, one from the library and one at-large member. Ex-officio members will include the Director of the Honors Program, the President of Honoris Causa (the Society of Honors Program Scholars) and a community member. Two subcommittees would be formed, with faculty members evenly distributed among both. The Programming Subcommittee will oversee curriculum, standards and assessment. The Scholarship & Awards committee will oversee the selection of scholarship recipients and make recommendations to the President of CSU for the allocation of all endowed scholarship funds.
